Consideration was also given to the Topic Paper on Housing Strategy that claims :

- the Barker Report recommendations have been more or less accepted by the government and reflected in the new PPS3
- that Doncaster has only 0.9 years supply of housing – “a desperate situation for Doncaster”
- the parish council is pursuing a ‘do nothing scenario’ on housing that is effectively taking Rossington backwards
- there needs to be a dramatic change in thinking with immediate effect.

A discussion ensued about the numbers of jobs that may or may not result from the Inland Port proposals and the links between jobs and housing. Further comments were made about the lack of a rigorous Rossington Forward Constitution.
